#### Wayne County Agricultural Fair – July



# Admire the Art

Fairfield Illinois boasts several murals, providing a great opportunity for locals and tourists alike to spend an afternoon on an art walk. Stop by Freedom Park on Main Street in downtown Fairfield and visit the mural

titled "Love Thou Thy Land" created by David & Cheryl Harl. This 78 x 21 mural was inspired by the poet Alfred Tennyson and depicts a blend of small-town America and the history of Fairfield including several historical buildings, businesses, and landmarks.

While in downtown, peek in some of the alleyways and you will be delighted to see an ever-expanding collection of murals created by our fabulous local artists. Large scale painted floral gardens, butterfly wings, social commentary, and more.

#### **Outdoor Recreation**

From walking and picnicking to challenging friends to disc golf, Fairfield offers a variety of recreational and outdoor activities for all ages.



#### Leo French Park - Park Road

Leo French Park, the largest in the entire county, has baseball diamonds, basketball court, picnic shelters and an Olympic size swimming pool. Situated on rolling wooded acreage, it features a small lake that is home for many geese, ducks and swans that enjoy treats brought to them by visitors. The lake is also surrounded by a paved walking path. During the Christmas Holiday Season, the park is the location for Fairfield's Festival of Lights.

## **Lakeside Park – Tice Clevenger Drive**

Offers lighted tennis courts, baseball, sand volleyball, ball diamonds, a playground and picnic shelter.



Garden of the Gods – Near Equality, IL



Looking for spectacular views with a short hike among some of the most unique rock formations in the United States? Look no further than Garden of the Gods in Southern Illinois. The most popular hike in the Shawnee National Forest, Garden of the Gods, gives tourists amazing insight into the geologic structure of Southern Illinois and a view that stretches for miles high over the pristine hills of Shawnee Forest.

#### **Shawnee Wine Trails – Southern Illinois**

## The Little Town That Made It Big – Casey, IL



The southeast Illinois town boasts 12 objects recognized by Guinness World Records and a bunch of other oversize items—all of them interactive. You can take a selfie swinging in the birdcage, posing on the pitchfork, or peeking in the wooden clogs.

#### Rend Lake - Near Benton, IL


